create a significant long-term savings, and will have the potential for	
linkage to Zone 4 to print names. Budget set at \$3000.	
Deck replacement must be done this year. Discussed obtaining engineer	
approved plans and volunteer assistance in removing the old deck.	
• The roof is to be done this summer; plexiglass added around the	

stairwell, and the septic bed inspected.	
Will disconnect internet service during the off season.	
• Tom has requested five pairs of snowshoes for rentals at \$100 each.	
Discussed adding more skis. \$500 budgeted for new skis (bindings can	
be stripped from other skis). Extra high school rental skis can be used	
for skate ski rentals or perhaps for the Jack Rabbit program.	
A drag will be built this fall. A replacement 1000 L fuel tank needs to be	
purchased.	
 Replacement of the purple bridge discussed in detail. Andrew Rees is 	
working with the MNR to get a plan approved. Culverts may not be an	
option; other possibilities are being researched. When a plan is chosen,	
the proposed cost can be determined. Discussed possible sources of	
funding for the project. Options will be looked at during the next board	
meeting.	
Discussed the by-pass of the Blue downhill. This may need to be postponed depending on the price of the bridge replacement.	
• Reviewed the membership rate analysis prepared by Gary. The board	
agreed to propose a 2% increase in membership fees.	
• Discussed a two-fee lesson price structure for Jack Rabbits, DEVO and	
Track Attack. Program fees will remain the same, however, a \$25	
deposit will be paid at registration which would be refunded after	
completion of volunteer work. Tom will prepare a detailed list of	
volunteer duties.	
• A program coordinator has not been included in the proposed budget.	TZ -11
