On Saturday, January 16, concerns were brought to the attention of board members about the congestion of people around the Clubhouse. The following day, various board members were on-site near the Clubhouse and gate entrance to observe and keep people from gathering in groups.

The Board agree to the following actions:

- More signage is required. Tom, Cathy and Mark will work on additional signs with larger print.
- We will sell day passes on Monday to Friday.
- Through a vote, increase staff presence and restrict access to members only on Saturday and Sunday.
- Through a vote, the rule will be a mask must be worn to receive service (one abstention).
- Create a mask zone near Clubhouse.
- Through a vote, at this time, we will not alter any trail direction.
- Communicate these changes to membership via email and social media.

On Saturday, there was potentially a group from Guelph. Through the Strava app, it was confirmed that these skiers were at the Club. Mark contacted one of the individual to advise that visitors from outside our local health unit should not ski at Nordic.
